Belt and Road Leadership Series: Regional Sustainable Development Forum cum Social Caring Pledge Scheme Award Presentataion Ceremony
Political and Business Leaders Shedding Lights on Sustainable Development, walking forward the Belt and Road Together

On November 21, the event Belt and Road Leadership Series: Regional Sustainable Development Forum cum Social Caring Pledge Scheme Award Presentation Ceremony was held at Harbour Grand Hong Kong. This forum persisted the spirit inspired by the host's previous forum held on August 31. Guest speakers discussed and shared their views on the International Relations, Financial Services and the Regional Sustainable Development fronts under the "Belt and Road" theme. In the presence of over 150 memebtrs from political, academic, and business communities promoting awareness of social caring, the hosting organization presented 35 awards, which included the Social Caring Leadership Award, the Outstanding Social Caring Organization Award and the its Yearly Outstanding Social Caring Organization Award, and the Outstanding Social Caring SME Organization Award.

The hosts were honoured to have invited the Under-Serectary for Transport and Housing Professor So Wai-man,Raymond, Raymond BBS JP, President of the Chinese Manufacturer's Association of Hong Kong Dr. Li.S.H. Eddy BBS JP , the Founder of Centraline Property Agency Limited Mr. Shih Wing-Ching as officiating guests, and Mr. Shih was also one of the guest speakers of the forum. The host were also honoured to have invited the Under Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury Mr. Joseph H.L. Chan, to give the welcoming speech, and Hong Kong's International Relations scholar Professor Simon Shen Xu Hui as one of the guest speakers.

Professor So Wai-man,Raymond, Raymond BBS JP mentioned MTR's contribution to the sustainable development of the "Belt and Road". He addeded that MTR's Public-Private Partnership operation model is conducive to communication and coopration between the Mainland and Hong Kong. The Under Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury Mr. Joseph H.L. Chan explored the influence of "Belt and Road" on the future prospect of the financial services industry. He also mentioned Fintech, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Big Data, and Green Finance and their importance to the financial services industry. Dr. Li.S.H. Eddy BBS JP emphasized the internationality of "Belt and Road" in his speech and opportunities for Hong Kong to leverage its advantages in "Belt and Road".

In the forum session, Mr. Shih Wing-Ching highlighted the importance of complying with environmental standards and requirements in "Belt and Road" development with reference to two cases , "Balancing Land Reclamation and Environmental Protection in Hong Kong" and "The Failure of Land Acquisition: Indonesia as Case". Professor Simon Shen Xu Hui explored the "Belt and Road" issue from the trade perspective with reference to Kazakhstan and Myanmar, and gave his remark on how the issue enlightens countries along the "Belt and Road" on the trade front. He also mentioned unique opportunity for Hong Kong in the midst of global challenges.
